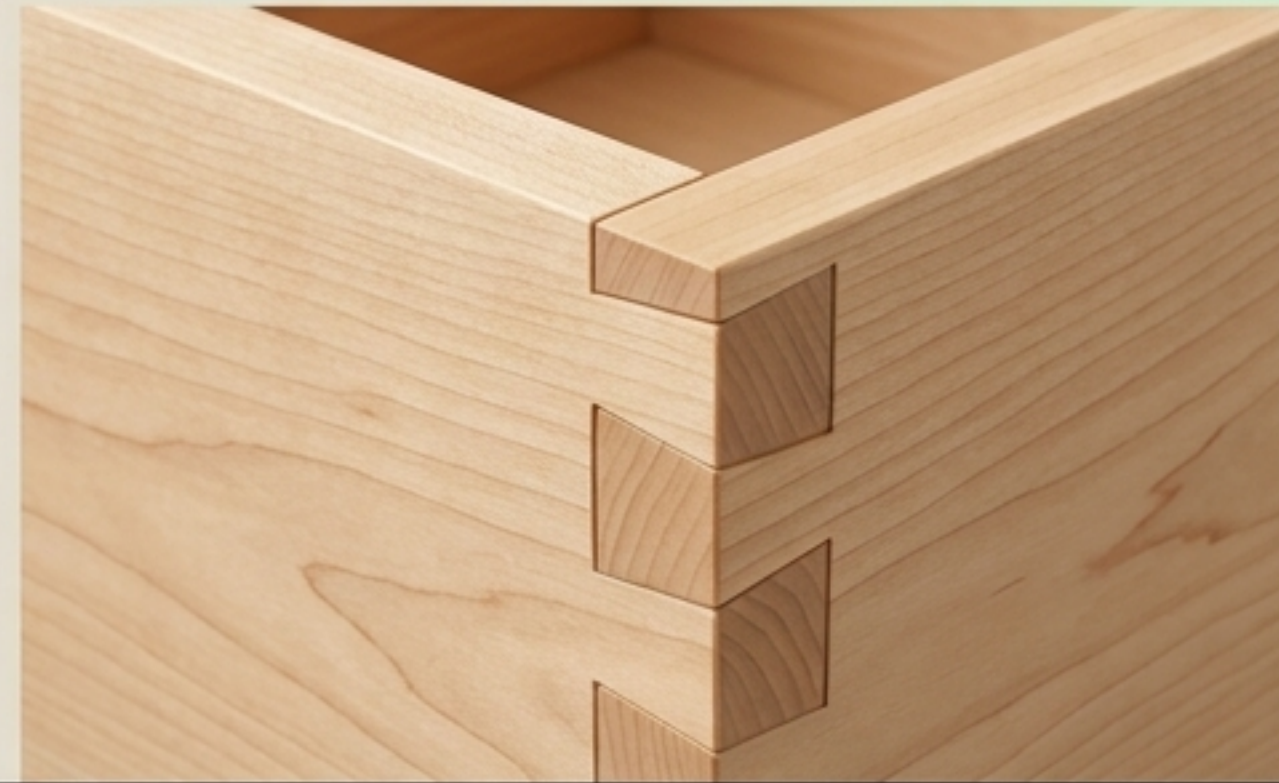
Summer moisture causes cheap materials to warp and painted MDF to crack at the joints.

Kiln-Dried Maple & Oak



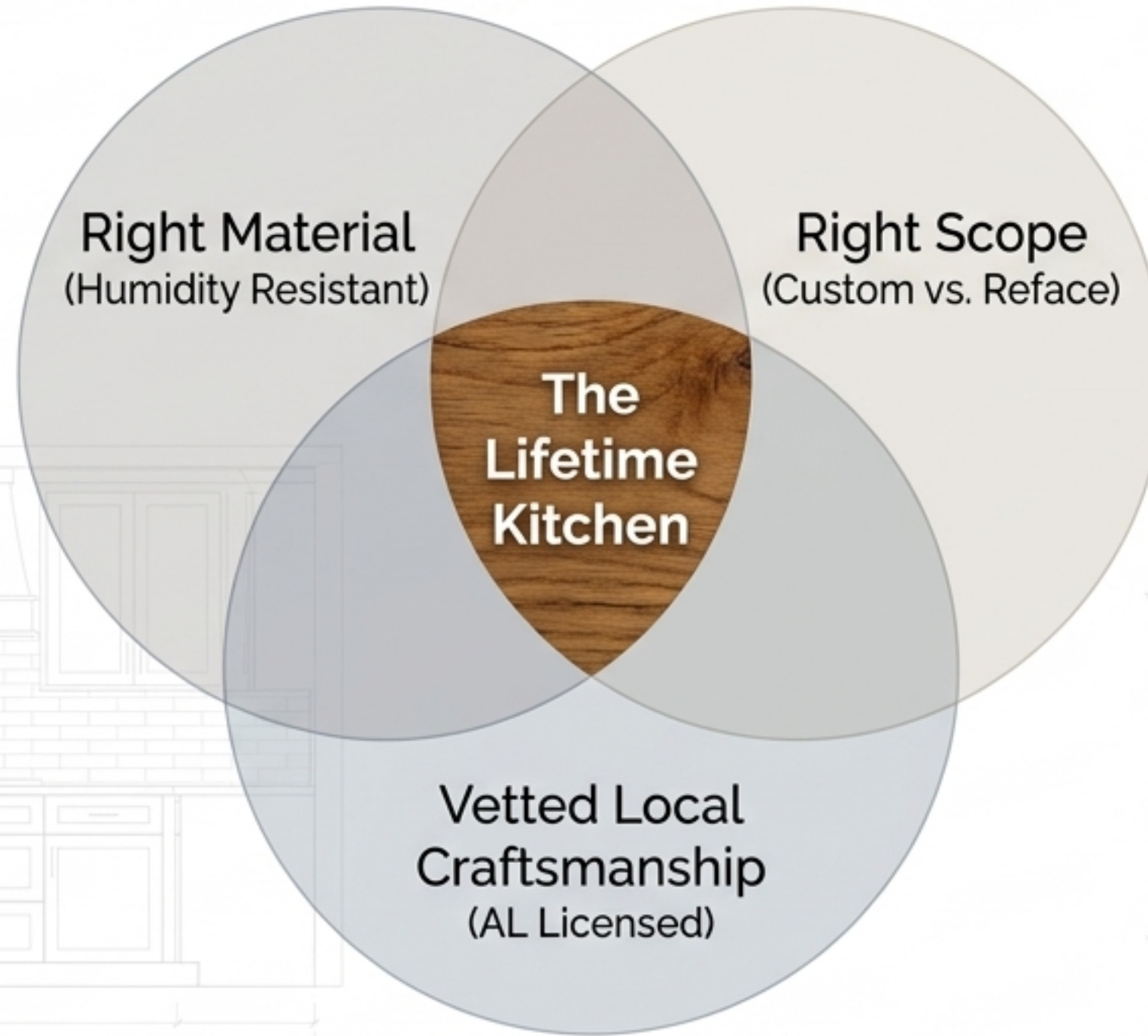
The Standard: Kiln-dried maple and oak provide ultimate structural stability. Avoid particle board at all costs.
